
PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 65 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Plaintiff presidential candidates and Ohio voters move for a temporary restraining order requiring Defendant Ohio Secretary of State Blackwell to begin immediately a complete and accurate state-wide recount in Ohio for the 2004 election for the President of the United States. Plaintiffs file in support of this motion the accompanying memorandum of law, declarations of Plaintiffs' experts and fact witnesses, Plaintiffs' exhibits, and a proposed order.
